Recruitment Update

Thank you to all sites that have contributed to the excellent recruitment for June, where we recruited our most ever patients in one month – **94!!!**

8 sites recruited 4 patients or more and have had hampers sent to them as thanks. Well done to Nottingham, Preston, St George's, North Staffs, Dewsbury, County Durham, New Cross, UK and to Tblisi State Medical Institute, Georgia.

Well done also to North Staffs for recruiting the fastest patient from stroke onset to randomisation in 3 hours 55 minutes.

As you know we have a target of 4,100 patients by end of April 2017. We need a recruitment rate of **65 patients per month** to achieve this.

Our average monthly rate over the last 6 months was 56, so we really need to keep up the recruitment.

The Independent Data Monitoring Committee took place on 7 March 2014. The committee did not have any safety concerns and recommended that the trial should continue. The DMC letter is on the Documents Website.

TARDIS documents update...

Updates include

➤ **New Protocol v1.5**
(effective from 22/4/14)



* Updated temperature IMP requirements.
* Addition of MR diffusion imaging to widen inclusion criteria.
* Update of dose ranges for international sites.

➤ **Updated GP letter v1.3**
to be used at baseline
(*further GP letters are sent out by the coordinating centre if patients are still on triple therapy beyond day 30 or on no medication after day 30*)



* Helping to prevent and react to patients continuing on triple and dual (aspirin and clopidogrel) antiplatelet therapy beyond the maximum treatment period of 28-30 days.
* Ensuring that after 28-30 days, patients go back onto guideline therapy, as per local practice.

➤ **New Randomisation**
and **updated**
Baseline CRF



* Simplified baseline form to allow for quicker randomisation, split into two separate CRFs; we now have a randomisation CRF.
* The key variables required for randomising a patient into the trial are on the randomisation form and further baseline information is now collected on the separate baseline form 24 hours later.

Protocol and GP letters have received all regulatory approvals-please ensure these documents are forwarded to R&D departments.

Tips of the month

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
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- Please advise us on **changes of PI's at local sites** in the following situations:

- * Secondment for 6 months. This is a significant period of time so a formal change of PI needs to occur. Whilst the amendment goes through, the delegated deputy can take over with the PI supervising.
- * Maternity or paternity leave for longer than 3 months.

The deputy/co PI needs to be able and competent to take over the role of PI during periods of absence and signed on the delegation log, with CV, GCP certificate and an active password.

- When sending CT scans via CD, please ensure they are labelled in the following way: **TARDIS Centre number/Trial number/Initials**.
- Payments need to be made promptly for HTA rules so please forward all documents asap so we can action payments. Invoices are not required.


