Hints and Tips of the month :

- Please aim to randomise patients as soon as possible after onset, ideally within 12 hours.
- Please aim to recruit more patients aged >70
- Please remember to ensure that all patients receive the allocated treatment after randomisation.
- Please do not recruit non English speaking patients as we are unable to complete their Day 90 telephone follow up.

Current Competition for TARDIS centres:

A hamper will be sent to each centre that recruits a patient within 3 hours and each centre that recruits 4 or more patients in 4 weeks

CT Scans

The TARDIS Image Upload system is available on the TARDIS web site.

Please see the Investigator Materials web page to access the documents below which will help with this process :

- Patient scans : what is required and where to send them (WPD 035)v1.0
- Uploading scans to the website (WPD 035a) v1.0

The first document gives basic information about the type of scans we require and how to ensure that you are set up to use the website upload.

The second includes screen shots of web pages used during the upload process. Please print and keep copies of these in your TARDIS Investigator site file.

For those used to uploading to the ENOS website, you will find that the TARDIS system is very similar.

If you have problems with the upload, it is still possible to send in CDs.

Please comply with the Working Practice Document – *Posting CT/MR scans (WPD 025)*. This can be accessed via the Investigator Materials web page or directly from the Data and Imaging administrator, Dawn Hazle; dawn.hazle@nottingham.ac.uk. Please let the trials team know of any problems you find with the upload or documents.

Please note – it is good clinical practice to do a scan (CT or MRI) after a recurrent event, certainly all stroke (and ideally TIA) - we can then use these scans to help adjudicate the events. If a MRI scan is done, ideally this should include : T2 and/or FLAIR, DWI and GRE/T2*/SWI.
