IMPORTANT RECRUITMENT UPDATE :

We are now running on the main HTA grant with the aim of recruiting a total of 4100 patients. HTA actively manages its grants, and the aim is for each centre to recruit 1-2 patients a month.

Please let the trial team know if there are any problems which are preventing or limiting recruitment below this level. We hope that changing the protocol to allow clopidogrel mono-therapy will allow sites who did not want to use combined aspirin/dipyridamole to re-start recruitment.

Your feedback on this would be greatly appreciated.
